What is PCLink 2003?

PCLink 2003

PCLink 2003 is a convenient software program for exchanging information between your PC and your mobile handset.

By connecting the two with a cable, you can download the data created on your PC to your mobile handset and also retrieve contents stored in your mobile handset to your PC for editing purposes.

◆ **Phonebook** Refer to page 14

Enables you to save personal information such as frequently used phone numbers and E-mail address and to send the data to your mobile handset.

◆ **Scheduler** Refer to page 25

Enables you to manage your schedule, appointments and anniversaries by using its subordinate functions : Event, Memo.

◆ **My Photo** Refer to page 32

You can export pictures taken with mobile phone's camera function to your PC.

◆ **My Movie** Refer to page 34

This feature is to download movie files taken from the camera phone to the PC.



System Requirements

- ▶ IBM compatible computer with a Pentium 133 MHz or higher processor
- ▶ 32 MB or higher RAM (64 MB is recommended)
- ▶ Free disk space of at least 20 MB
- ▶ Windows 98/2000/xp
- ▶ 2X or higher CD-ROM drive
- ▶ Serial or PS2 mouse
- ▶ 800x600, 256 color or higher resolution
- ▶ Phone-compatible serial cable
- ▶ PCLink 2003 installation file
- ▶ Mobile handset (compatible with PCLink 2003)

First Quit all Windows applications before beginning, then run PCLink 2003 installation File.






Connecting Your Phone to PC

You should connect your mobile handset to PC to use PCLink 2003.



- note**
- ▶ Do not use a USB port has memory resident software(i.e.pcAnywhere or PalmHotSync®) loaded and configured for it. If your system only has one serial port, you must exit any such software to allow PCLink 2003 to use the port.
 - ▶ To disconnect the cable from your phone, press gray buttons on the right and left sides of the end of cable, then pull the cable out.

Running PCLink 2003



First Connect your phone to the PC with the data cable; refer to page 8.



1 Double-click PCLink icon on the desktop

- ▶ You can run PCLink 2003 from the **Start** menu. Select **Program, Samsung**, then select **PCLink**.




When you point a menu icon with mouse pointer, the background color of the menu icon will turn black. If you click on the menu icon, the appropriate menus will be opened, but Scheduler and Message menu will display sub menus instead.

-  **PHONEBOOK**
Enables you to create/edit/delete a phone number, address, etc.
-  **SCHEDULER**
Enables you to store brief memos, events, and to use the countdown function.
-  **MY PHOTO**
You can export pictures taken with mobile phone's camera function to your PC
-  **MY MOVIE**
This feature is to download movie files taken from the camera phone to the PC.



- Open** Opens a saved database. Typing Ctrl+O is also available.
- Save** Saves the database. Typing Ctrl+S is also available.
- Data Convert** Imports / Exports CSV files; refer to page 38.
- Print** Prints the displayed contents.
- Exit** Quits PCLink 2003 program.



- Toolbar** Shows or hides the tool bar on the screen.



- Sync** Synchronizes the data in your phone with the PC.
- PC to Phone** Writes the data in the PC to your phone.
- Phone to PC** Reads the data in your phone to the PC.
- Phonebook** **Scheduler** **My Photo** **My Movie**
Opens the appropriate menu.
- Configuration** Sets up the configuration.









To send Phonebook data to your phone, you should make them Synced. Otherwise, they will be stored in the PC only.

To Make Synced



Drag and drop the item you want to sync to Synced

- Or, click the right mouse button and select **Synced**.
- If making the record **Synced** is accomplished successfully,  will be displayed on the left of the item, and the Hotkey (speed dial) number will be assigned automatically. To change the Hotkey (speed dial) number, refer to page 19.





To sync automatically



The reason for the Synced and Unsynced categories is that Synced databases are limited to the maximum Phonebook capacity of your handset; Unsynced databases can hold an unlimited amount of data.



Group

You can create,edit,delete phone number group or change melodies per the group.



Group list


First Click New button, and then Enter new name in the Window then click OK.

Select a name of the group you wish to change on the list, then Enter new name in the Window, then click OK.

Select a name of the group you wish to delete on the list, then Click delete button, then click OK.

Changing Hotkey(Speed dial) Number

You can change the Hotkey (speed dial) number assigned when you save items.

A window which has the other Hotkey (speed dial) numbers appears.

2 Select a new number

You can select a number between 1 and the maximum number of phone book entries allowed by your handset except concealed number(s); if a number is in use, it is not displayed on the window.



Synchronization with Your Mobile Handset



My Photo

Above is the basic screen after clicking "My Photo"
 Displayed is a navigation pane, which is shown before the images are retrieved from the terminal. A message inquiring about the folder for saving will appear by clicking on the "Save to PC" button.

My Photo With Images

Above is the basic screen of 'My Photo', after an image has been selected.

1 Shows images as Thumbnails.

2 Displays the image selected from Thumbnail in full size.

3 This screen adjusts the size of the screen which is shown in 2.


4 Adjust the adjusted size back to 100% using 3.

Image Viewer


My Movie





5 The selected files will be save to the designated folder when pressing [OK] button



Data Convert Import/Export

You can import/export data with CSV files in order to be compatible with outside programs and data.

Uninstallation

If necessary, you can delete PCLink 2003 and reinstall the program.

First Insert the PCLink 2003 installation CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive, then select PCLink 2003.







- ◆ If you want to install PCLink 2003 or its sister programs again, you should reboot your PC before reinstallation.



Troubleshooting

Printing Problem

Poor communication between the printer and the computer may cause garbled printing or printer error messages in Windows NT and Windows 2000.

This may be caused by incorrect parallel port configuration in the computer setup utility. Below is a list of some of the common parallel port settings with a brief explanation for each:



For information on checking or changing the parallel port configuration, see the computer documentation or contact the computer manufacturer.

ECP

ECP stands for Extended Capabilities Port. This setting allows the computer parallel port to send and receive data in both directions simultaneously.

This is the preferred and the fastest type of communication available to printers. It is the preferred parallel port setting for most printers.

SPP, Output, Compatible, Standard, or Centronics

These settings allow the parallel port to operate in an output-only mode where data can be sent out to the printer. In this mode, the parallel port can also receive limited feedback from the printer.

These can be alternate port settings for some printers if the ECP port setting is not available.

Synchronization Problem

Please check the following things:

- ◆ Always make sure that the mobile handset is switched on and the battery is full.
- ◆ Be sure that PC and your mobile handset are linked together by a cable.
- ◆ Be sure that Com port, which is used by PCLink 2003, is not being used by another device, such as modem or serial mouse.
- ◆ Check if your mobile handset supports PCLink 2003.
